



**Capital Workforce Partners
2009-2010 WIA Youth Contract Funding Recommendations
September 17, 2009**

Considerations for funding are:

- Geographic distribution to include programming in Hartford, New Britain and Bristol aligned with number of out of school youth transitioning from SYELP: 63% Hartford; 27% New Britain; 10% Bristol
- Services for high school dropouts and high school graduates
- Training focused on Allied Health, Advanced Manufacturing, Construction/Green Technology
 - Contextualized basic skills
 - Occupational skills training
- Score of 70 points or higher required for funding consideration
