- 10.** Held the first targeted Engineering and Manufacturing Career and Resource Expo and Press Event that received high marks from businesses and job seekers.
- 9.** Held the first statewide, One-Stop staff professional development retreat, at which 260 line staff and managers increased their workforce development knowledge, skills and drive for optimum performance.
- 8.** Designed, implemented and began seeing results from a comprehensive and strategic Four Pillars Employer Engagement model.
- 7.** Successfully implemented the remaining Board Governance Committee recommendations after a comprehensive restructuring.
- 6.** Successfully implemented new One-Stop operating structure for greater efficiencies.
- 5.** Secured a visit from U.S. DOL Secretary Hilda Solis to headline our Jobs Funnel ten-year anniversary celebration.
- 4.** Kick-started the Jobs First Employment Services (JFES) program and brought it back to full capacity after it was shut down on June 30th 2009 because of state budget cuts.
- 3.** Implemented a very successful, ARRA-funded Summer Youth Employment and Learning Program serving 2,005 participants under intense timeline and regulation pressures.
