**Contracting Recommendations**

Co-Chairs Report:

1. Attached are the Tier I and II contracts recommendations for the 2009 Summer Youth Employment and Learning Program. Based on the rating and review process, these service providers were deemed eligible for funding pending availability of State of Connecticut, City of Hartford and private funds. All are returning providers with no outstanding monitoring or programmatic issues.
  
2. The Future Workforce Services Committee further recommends that it be empowered by the Board to agree on actual contract amounts based on funding availability, geographic distribution, and youth service needs – particularly around which tier is funded based on age and any past experience in SYELP. These decisions would be made at the standing Future Workforce Services Committee meeting in May.
