Child Development Associate-CDA Certificate Program

Upon completion you will be able to apply for the CDA credential from Washington, D.C. This credential will help you gain employment in entry-level positions in early childhood settings. Business Management and Customer Relations

Advanced Skills for Healthcare Workers

The Advanced Skills for Healthcare Workers program is designed to assist the entry-level healthcare worker to begin the process of transitioning into a supervisory position, while gaining greater clinical experience. Topics covered include phlebotomy training, healthcare regulations, medical terminology, anatomy and physiology, Alzheimer's disease and other mental health issues affecting the elderly.



Retail or Hospitality Customer Service Training

If you're interested in working for a hotel, resort, casino or retail shop, then the Career Academy for Service Excellence's Retail or Hospitality Training program could be the short-term solution for you. This 15-week, in-school, 15-week, on-the-job program is designed to provide you with the skills necessary to succeed in the hospitality or retail career fields. Graduates of the program are eligible for certification by the American Hotel and Lodging Association or the National Retail Federation.
