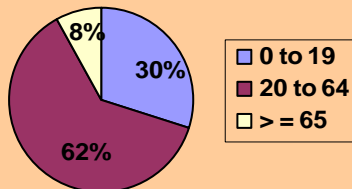




Town of Burlington Workforce Profile

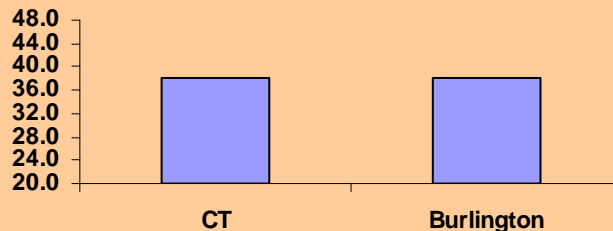
The Town of Burlington is located 14 miles west of Hartford and has a land area of 29.8 square miles with a population of 8,578 residents.

Resident's Age Distribution



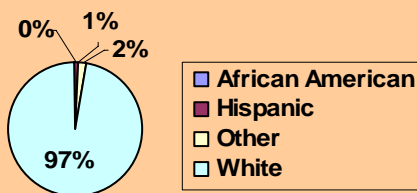

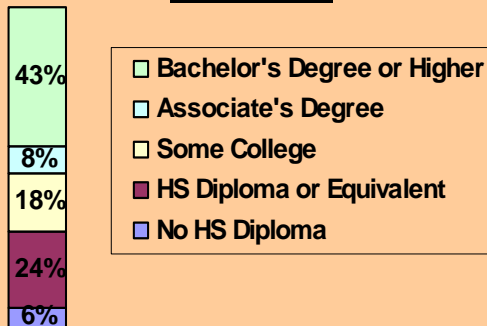
