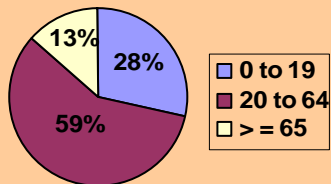




City of New Britain Workforce Profile

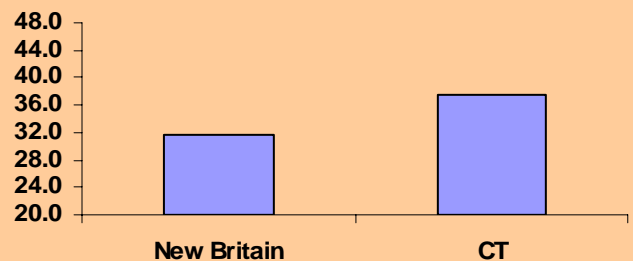
The City of New Britain is 9 miles southwest of Hartford and has a land area of 13.3 square miles with a population of 66,492 residents.

New Britain's Age Distribution



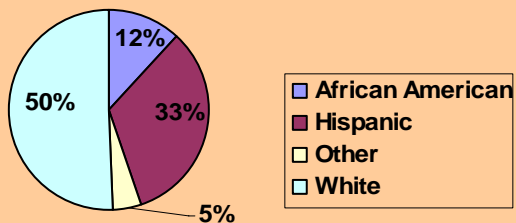

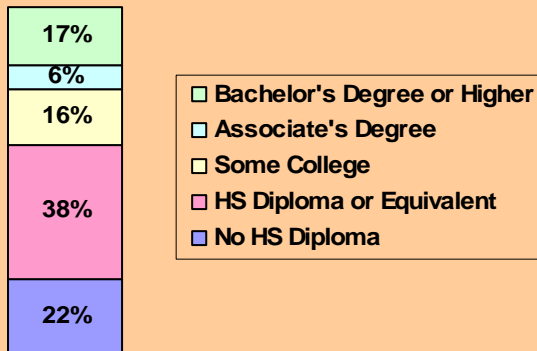
