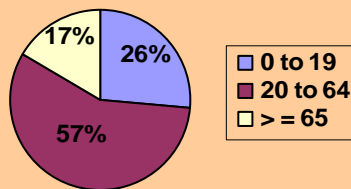




Town of West Hartford Workforce Profile

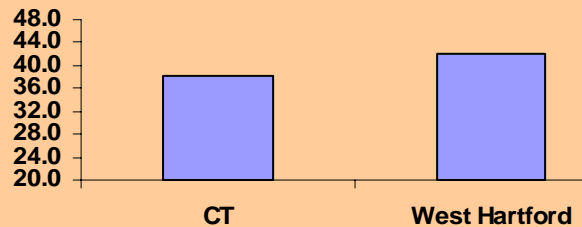
The Town of West Hartford is 4 miles west of Hartford and has a land area of 22.2 square miles with a population of 58,360 residents.

West Hartford's Age Distribution



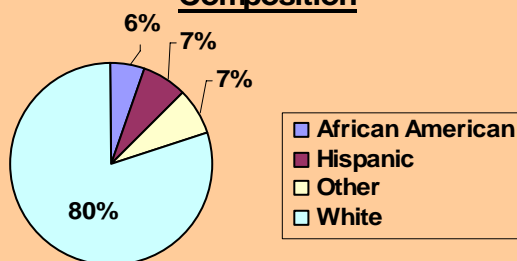

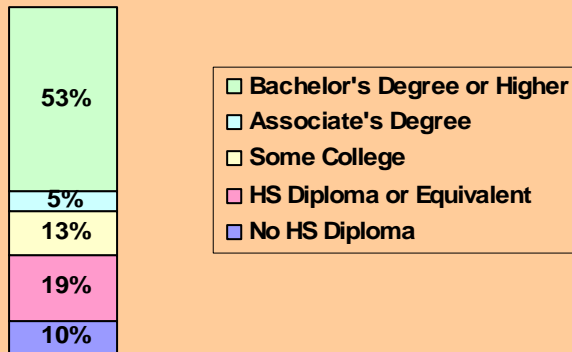
