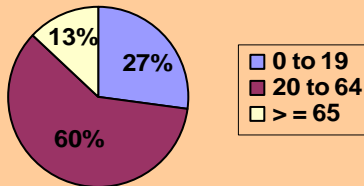




Town of Windsor Workforce Profile

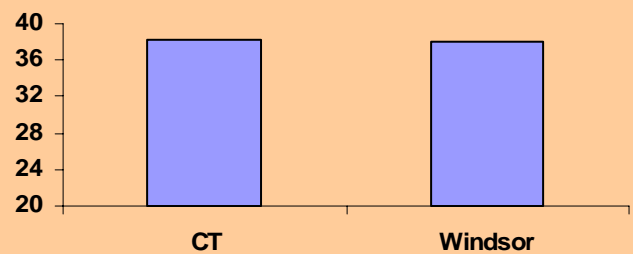
The Town of Windsor is 7 miles north of Hartford and has a land area of 30 square miles with a population of 28,150 residents.

Windsor's Age Distribution



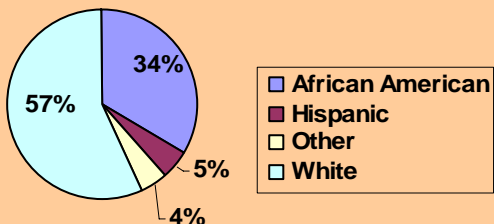

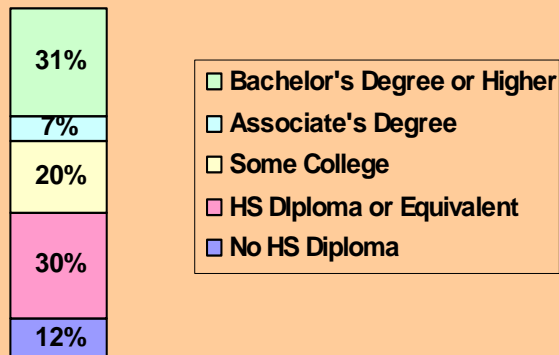
